HISTORY

The Sickle Cell Foundation of Palm Beach County & Treasure Coast, Inc. (SCF) is a non-profit health organization that has been in existence since 1973. Incorporation papers were filed with the Secretary of State in December 1979 and incorporation status was awarded on March 4, 1980. The organization later received its 501(c)(3) designation from the U.S. Internal Revenue Service. SCF provides services to a 5-county area and is the only entity covering Palm Beach, Martin, Okeechobee, St. Lucie, and Indian River counties that is dedicated to serving persons affected by Sickle Cell.

The total staff configurations include the CEO, Executive Assistant, Finance Director, Community Voice Director, Case Manager, and Lay Health Educators. SCF has 8 Full-Time Staff, 1 Part-Time position, and 2 Contractual Staff who are engaged in assisting with some of the grantfunded activities. There is a cadre of volunteers who assist with health fairs, community events, and fundraisers.


2022 ANNUAL REPORT ACCREDITATION

As a nonprofit organization, SCF relies heavily on grant funding, corporate sponsors/partners, fundraisers, and donations from the public. Our largest funder is the Children's Service Council of Palm Beach County, Inc. Other grantors include the Children's Service Council of Martin County, Health Care District of Palm Beach County, Palm Beach County Housing and Community Development (CDBG), FPL, Novartis, Global Blood Therapeutics and Children's Healthcare Charity (Honda Classic). SCF constantly seeks to develop collaborative relationships and agreements with other entities in the community.



CASE MANAGEMENT REPORT

Case management report- Here is a previous one as an example: During the year 2022, SCF provided case management/care coordination. In March, we transition to telehealth solutions that included video chat and telephone visits. Outreach, education and screening services were provided to individuals and family units throughout Palm Beach County and the Treasure Coast.

Outreach and education was provided through partnerships via social media platforms to approximately 1,850 individuals.

COMMUNITY VOICE REPORT

During the year 2021 - 2022, 574 Lay Health Advisors have been educated about Black infant mortality/morbidity rates; preconception; prenatal care; alcohol and drugs; stress and domestic violence; breastfeeding, nutrition, SIDS; and Taking It To the People.

SCF celebrated the 13th Anniversary of the Community Voice program in Palm Beach County and achieved a milestone of seeing the Black infant mortality rates decrease since the data was been collected. We have educated over 8,000 individuals since the inception of the program.

Community Voice is funded by the Children's Service Council of Palm Beach County.
